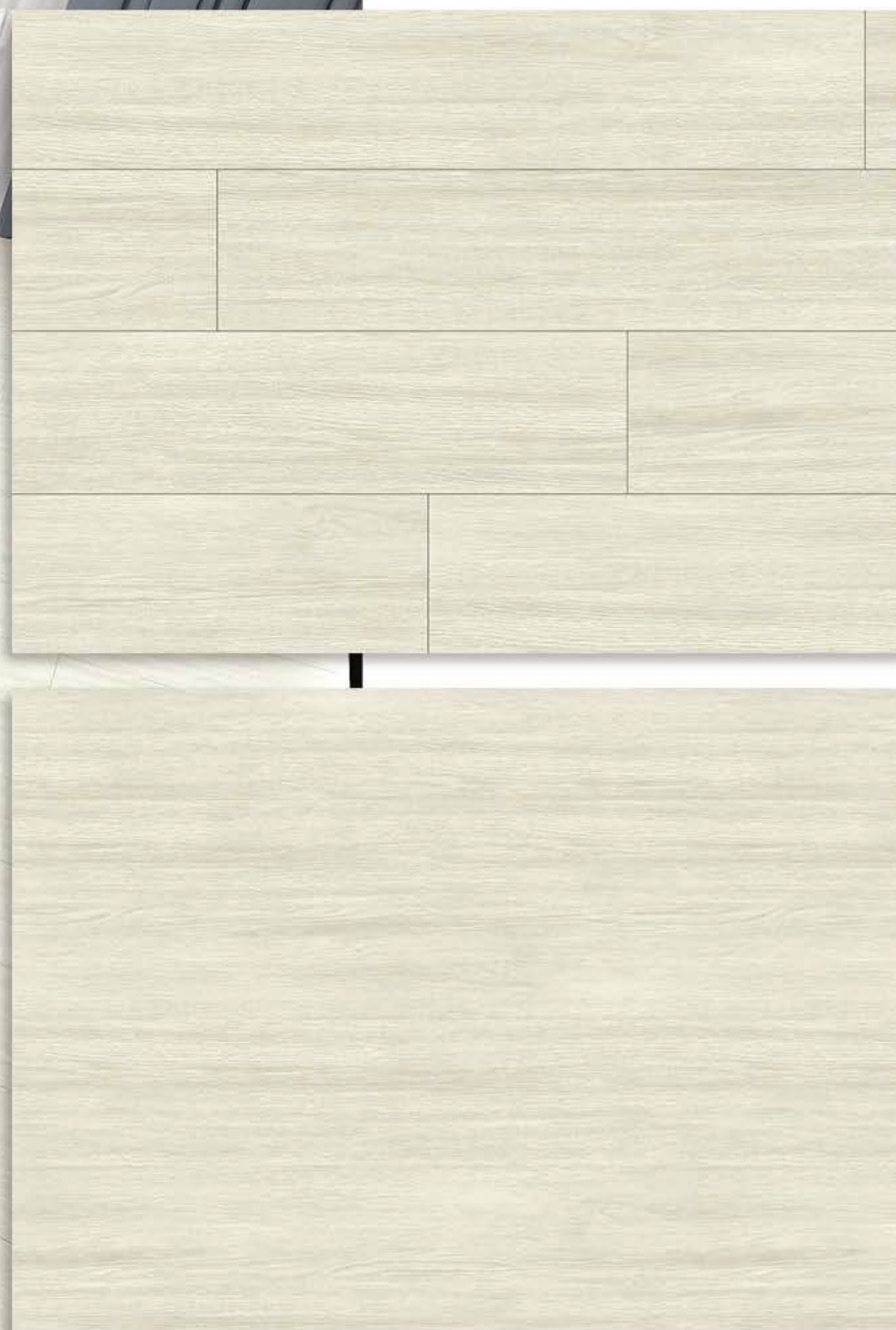

CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES FOR SPC FLOORING

MAINTENANCE

SPC flooring is intended exclusively for indoor use. After installation, keep the room temperature between 5°C and 35°C, with relative humidity maintained between 40% and 65%.

Ensure the area remains clean and protected until all construction work is finished and the furniture is in place. Avoid walking on the floor with outdoor shoes, especially if they are wet or carry sand, gravel, soil, or mud. To reduce dirt and prevent damage, place doormats at every exterior entrance.

Shield the flooring from direct sunlight by using curtains or blinds. During periods of intense sunlight, keep them closed to prevent fading of both the floor and surrounding furniture.

If using underfloor heating—preferably water-based—raise the temperature gradually and ensure the surface never exceeds 27°C. Avoid placing hot objects directly on the floor, as they may cause permanent damage.

Do not drag heavy furniture. Chair and furniture legs should be wide (minimum 2.5 cm / 1 inch), made of non-pigmented hard plastic, and rest flat on the surface. Use non-staining felt pads and avoid soft rubber protectors, which can trap dirt and leave marks. Replace or clean the pads regularly.

For office chairs, use wheels suitable for vinyl flooring and place protective mats underneath. Clean or replace the wheels periodically to prevent wear.

When moving heavy appliances or furniture, never slide them directly on the floor. Always use a protective base such as a mat or board, even when using wheeled equipment.

Prevent impacts from hard objects and keep pet nails trimmed. Clean spills immediately to avoid moisture infiltration. Do not install extremely heavy furniture or screw decorative elements into the flooring, as this may cause surface irregularities.

CLEANING

SPC flooring is easy to maintain. Sweep or vacuum regularly to remove dust and abrasive particles. Once a week, clean with a damp cloth and fresh water. If using specialized cleaning products, follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully, as excessive use may leave a dulling residue.

Avoid steam cleaners.

The floor is highly stain-resistant. Most spills can be removed with a clean white cloth. For more stubborn stains, wipe gently and allow the area to dry completely.

Do not use wax, bleach, polishing machines, or abrasive detergents.

For sticky residues, gently scrape with a non-sharp tool. For difficult stains, apply a household intensive cleaner directly on the spot for no more than 15 minutes. Scrub with a soft pad or brush in circular motions. Rinse with water and dry immediately. Repeat if necessary.
